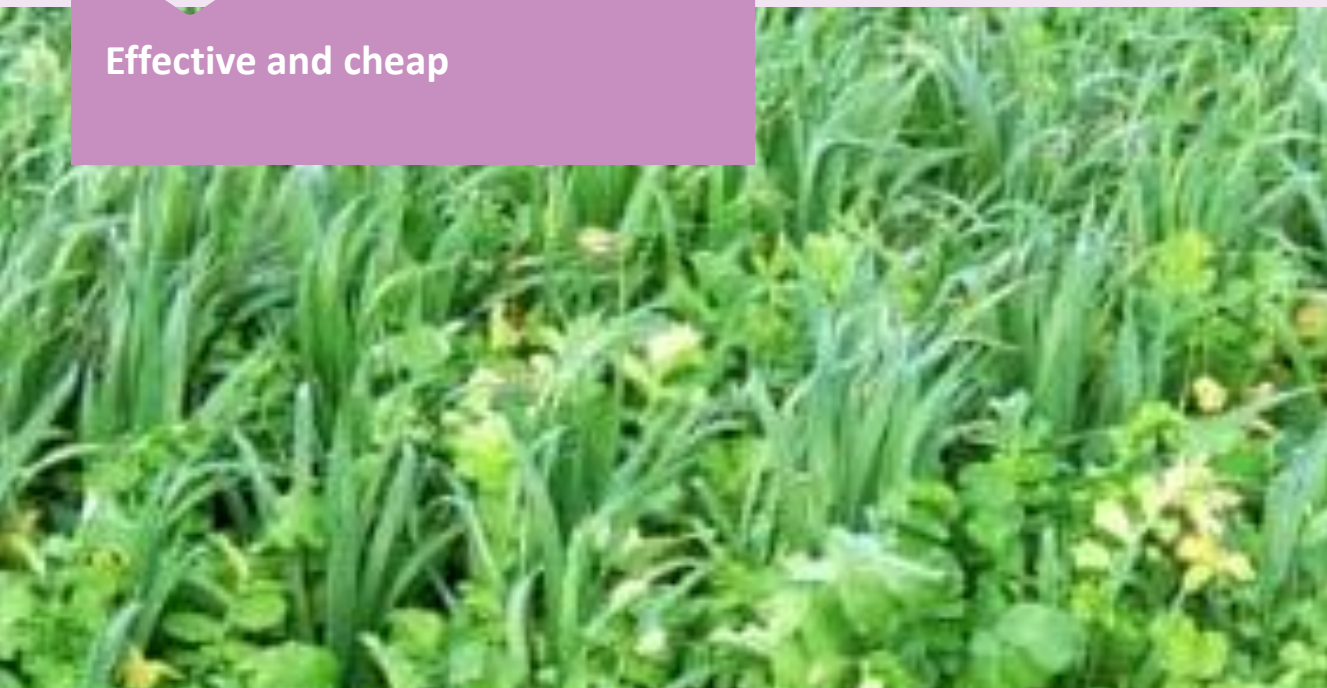


Effective and cheap



- Mixture of Oats and White mustard suitable for minimum tillage
- Frost sensitive if sown early (by September 10<sup>th</sup> in the Po Valley), and with predisposing weather conditions
- The mixture of Mustard and Oats has improved compared to cruciferous vegetables alone for the following reasons:
  - Better nitrogen trap effect thanks to the fasciculate roots of cereals
  - Better competition vs weeds
  - Greater contribution of organic matter and better surface porosity of soil

Common oat, White mustard

Field crops, vegetables

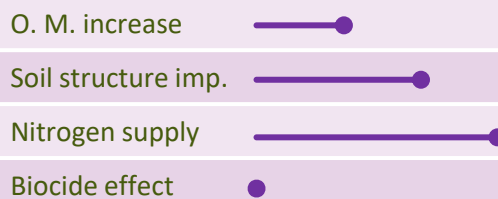
## SEEDING RATE
