

Mixture of cruciferous and Phacelia with a structuring and decompacting effect on the soil

The **decompacting effect** of this mix is particularly effective because it operates at three levels in soil thanks to the complementary characteristics of components:

- Minowase radish makes a decompacting effect thanks to its wedge-shaped and deep roots
- Brown mustard: its taproot system helps to structure the soil in depth and is an effective nitrate trap
- Phacelia: its deep fasciculate root system promotes an excellent micro-porosity

Phacelia, Brown mustard, Minowase radish

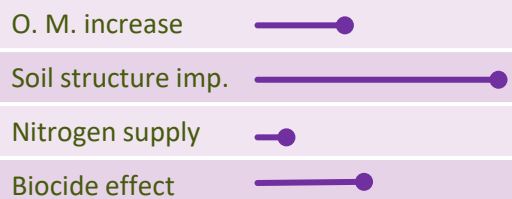
