

# COMMON VETCH



Vetch is an excellent green manure essence for its good nitrogen-fixing activity and for the rapidity of soil cover with excellent ability to limit weeds. It is typically used in mixtures with oats, Italian ryegrass and pea.

Usually, it is a mowing forage to be sown in Autumn in the mild climate regions and in Spring in the northern regions (mainly in purity).

## CRISTINA



- Mid-early variety able to provide excellent yield in both grain and forage.



- Characterized by a good vegetative development at late winter and by remarkable hardiness; it adapts very well to different soil types, ensuring always high yield.

**SOWING PERIOD (pure)** Autumn in Central-South areas  
Spring in Northern areas

**SEEDING RATE:** 80 - 120 kg/ha

**CICLO:** Medium-early
