

COMMON VETCH



Vetch is an excellent green manure essence for its good nitrogen-fixing activity and for the rapidity of soil cover with excellent ability to limit weeds. It is typically used in mixtures with oats, Italian ryegrass and pea.

Usually, it is a mowing forage to be sown in Autumn in the mild climate regions and in Spring in the northern regions (mainly in purity).

MARIANNA



- An undemanding and hardy plant that grows in unfavorable conditions (hot-wet) of Southern Italy latitudes.



- Medium-early cycle plant which fits well consociated with oats for hay production.

SOWING PERIOD (pure) Autumn in Central-South areas
Spring in Northern areas

SEEDING RATE: 80 - 120 kg/ha

CICLO: Medio - precoce
