

COMMON VETCH



Vetch is an excellent green manure essence for its good nitrogen-fixing activity and for the rapidity of soil cover with excellent ability to limit weeds. It is typically used in mixtures with oats, Italian ryegrass and pea.

Usually, it is a mowing forage to be sown in Autumn in the mild climate regions and in Spring in the northern regions (mainly in purity).

MIRABELLA



- Variety obtained by the ISCF of Lodi and widespread in all cultivation areas of the crop and, in particular in the Center-South of Italy.

- Compared to *Idice* it is about a week earlier and is more suitable for mild climates.
